Two Questions about Prayer

I. Why does the Bible say to persevere in prayer?

Because, **prayer changes what is possible.**

“...for My house will be called a house of prayer for all peoples.” ~ Isaiah 56:7

Two Steps to Persevere

1. Pray **simply**
2. Pray **boldly**

“Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.” ~ Hebrews 4:16

“Keep on praying.” ~ Ephesians 6:18

“Pray continually...” ~ 1 Thessalonians 5:17

What do I do while waiting for an answer?

1. Wait **patiently**

“Blessed are those that wait on Him.”
~ Isaiah 30:18

2. Wait **expectantly**

“I waited for the Lord, He turned to me and heard my cry.” ~ Psalm 40:1

Two things to remember:

1. God is in **control** and **you're not.**
2. Remember God will honor **your patience.**
