1. He will guide **your words**.

2. He will guide **your interaction with people**.

"He said to them: "You are well aware that it is against our law for a Jew to associate with a Gentile or visit him. But God has shown me that I should not call any man impure or unclean.'" ~ Acts 10:28

"Then Peter began to speak: "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism..." ~ Acts 10:34

Guidance is not just about us **performing**, it's about us **transforming**.

⁸ "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you. ⁹ Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle or they will not come to you."
